№.5® PILOT COUPLER CONVERSION

1. Remove screw holding pilot and loco frame together. File away 1/32" of the bottom front of loco frame about 3/8" back from frame end. Be sure to file flat and level. Drill out hole in frame end with a #43 drill to clear a 2-56 screw. See Fig.1.

2. Cut away a 5/16" wide opening in the coupler pocket and cut to the surface of the top of the coupler pocket. Remove the bottom piece of the coupler pocket, see Fig.1.

3. Assemble $^{N_0}5^{\otimes}$ Coupler. Use a plastic compatible cement sparingly along seams only to hold assembly together. Trim side mounting lugs off flush with sides. Cut off front flange of lid flush with top. Secure with a 2-56 screw inserted from below and 2-56 nut above.

4.Check for correct coupler height, function, and clearance and make any ^{No.}5[®] Installation adjustments necessary.
