#37 COUPLER CONVERSION

- 1. Remove body shell and coupler from the chassis.
- **2.** Carefully remove the side walls (shaded portion) of the coupler pocket flush with the coupler mounting surface, see Fig.1. Drill through the second hole (A), located approximately 1/8" from the front hole (B), with a #50 drill and tap hole for 2-56 threads. See Fig.2.
- **3.** The locomotive pilot coupler opening bottom edge should be carefully filed down enough to allow the coupler assembly to enter.
- **4.** Assemble the #37 Coupler with the coupler on top and the Torsion Spring on the bottom. Do not use the coupler lid. See Fig.2.
- **5.** Align and secure coupler with 2-56 screw.
- **6.** Check for correct coupler height, function, and clearance and make any adjustments necessary.
