



HO -

"THOMAS engine" - USE #20 NEM with a screw through the shank into the end sill - if needed glue a piece of styrene to the inside for the screw.


"James" FRONT #38 TENDER NEM #20 with a screw through the shank -

"MOST CARS" - These usually have a post that you can use the #20 NEM. Trim the post down for correct coupler height and run the screw through the shank into the post.

These models are a matter of mounting a coupler at the correct height. The large offset of our NEM couplers keep you from cutting the end sill too much.
