MC KEAN #29 COUPLER CONVERSION

1. If assembled, remove trucks from the underbody and remove existing couplers.


2. Remove McKean coupler pocket flush with car floor. File smooth and flat.

3. Drill and tap a 2-56 hole 1/4" from car end on car centerline.

4. Assemble the #29 Coupler with Centering Spring on top and place in a ^{No} 5[®] box (included with 20-Series Couplers). You may wish to glue box and lid together. Use a tiny amount of plastic compatible cement along seams only.

5. Secure the #29 Coupler with a 2-56 screw trimmed flush with top of the car floor.

6. Check for correct coupler height, function, and clearance and make #29 Installation any adjustments necessary.



Remove McKean coupler pocket entirely. File surface smooth and flat. Drill and tap 2-56 hole 1/4" from car end on car centerline
