

TYCO NO. 5® PILOT COUPLER CONVERSION

- 1. Remove existing coupler.
- **2.** Modify the pilot coupler opening by removing sides and bottom completely. Make opening 5/16" wide. Remove top of pocket until it is flush and level with bottom side of pilot deck. See Fig.1.
- **3.** Assemble the $^{No.}5^{\circ}$ Coupler with the Centering spring on top. Glue box and lid together with a small amount of plastic compatible cement. After glue has dried, modify the $^{No.}5^{\circ}$ box and lid by cutting off the side mounting lugs. See Fig.1.
- **4.** Install No.5® coupler assembly in pilot from the front, center and secure with glue. If you wish, you may secure coupler with a 2-56 screw. To do this, drill and tap a 2-56 hole on loco centerline 1/4" from the front of the coupler pocket. Then use a 2-56 screw of appropriate length to secure coupler.

*27 TENDER TRUCK (TALGO) COUPLER CONVERSION

- **5.** Assemble the #27 Coupler into the truck mounted coupler box according to the 20-Series instructions. See Fig.2.
- **6.** Check for correct coupler height, function, and clearance and make any adjustments necessary.

NOTE: For body mounted coupler installation use a No.5® Coupler and shim to correct height.
