


## TYCO STREAMLINED PASSENGER CARS

No.5® COUPLER CONVERSION (NEWER PLASTIC BODY)


- **1.** Turn the car upside down and remove the floor. Swing truck sideways and remove original coupler assembly.
- **2.** Assemble the No.5® Coupler per instructions. Glue lid and box together with a plastic compatible cement applied sparingly along seams only.
- **3.** Enlarge mounting hole in coupler mounting bracket with a #50 Drill. Place No.5® Coupler assembly on top of the mounting bracket, align holes and secure with a #2 by 3/16" self tapping screw. See Fig.1.
- **4.** Check for correct coupler height, function, and clearance and make any adjustments necessary.

## No.5® COUPLER CONVERSION (OLDER METAL BODY)

- **1.** Turn the car upside down and remove the floor. Swing truck sideways and remove original coupler assembly.
- **2.** Assemble the No.5® Coupler per coupler instructions. Glue lid and box together with a plastic compatible cement applied sparingly along seams only.
- **3.** Enlarge mounting hole closest to end of coupler mounting bracket with a  $^{\#}50$  Drill and tap 2-56. Place  $^{No}.5^{\otimes}$  Coupler assembly on the bottom of the mounting bracket, align holes and secure with a 2-56 screw. See Fig. 2.
- **4.** Check for correct coupler height, function, and clearance and make any adjustments necessary.
