№.5® COUPLER CONVERSION

1. Remove existing trucks. Carefully remove coupler pocket covers and discard couplers. Save trucks and covers.

2. Modify ${}^{No}5^{\odot}$ Lid by cutting off top lip and trimming equal amounts from sides to just fit the Varney coupler pocket. The ${}^{No}5^{\odot}$ Lid should then be able to slip over centerpost pin.

3. Place $^{No.5\%}$ Coupler with Centering Spring on top over modified upside down $^{No.5\%}$ Lid. Then slip coupler assembly with lid over centerpost pin and into Varney coupler pocket, see Fig.2. Glue lid at post/pin and along side seams with a tiny amount of plastic compatible cement. Do not allow cement to enter pocket or touch coupler.

4. Option: If pin is broken, drill and tap 2-56 hole where pin was and use 2-56 screw.

5. Check for correct coupler height, function, and clearance and make any adjustments necessary.
